Thank you very much for your letter of 19/5.  
I know that the questions I have sent  
you could be answered by the state of  
necessity we are living. But you know  
that even under this circumstance any  
Catholic would look for some signals which  
characterize the authority in our Church.  
That's the reason of my letter, because, as  
you agree with me, all these consecrations  
did not improve the Catholic resistance,  
but created a dispersion of forces and ideas.

I have a friend studying with Mr. Storch  
who will be ordained deacon this month.  
Probably I will take the occasion, if coming  
to München in my way to Fatima, to visit  
you as suggested. There is an initiative,  
regarding our resistance, which is ex-  
posed in our "Pentecost Letter" that I would  
like to discuss with you.

I have also a work on the "Cum ex Apo-  
stolatus officio" that may interest you, but  
it is still in Italian.
