

HABEMUS PAPAM!

On Monday, July 16, 1990, the Feast of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel at 9:45 am, David Allen Bawden was canonically elected Pope by the representatives of the One, Holy, Catholic and Apostolic Church and took the name of Michael. "Fiat voluntas Tua", (Thy will be done) was chosen for the Papal Motto.

"And there was a great battle in Heaven, Michael and his angels fought with the dragon...", Apocalypse 12:7. The name of Michael is quite significant. In addition to our devotion to this archangel from a young age, we fully expect Michael to wage war with the System of Antichrist. The very name itself is appropriate, as it means, "Who is like God?" In this time, when the perfidious heresy that we are all a piece of God is everywhere found and the democratic idea that all people together form God is widely taught, it is appropriate to remember, that we are made in His image and likeness and owe God full obedience and that ALL authority comes ultimately from Almighty God and from no other source.

Letter to the Faithful

We encourage each member of the Church to remain firm and steadfast in the Profession of the Holy Faith and the acceptance of ALL that Christ taught. To do this we strongly encourage study of the Faith for one hour each week, preferably on Sunday from the approved Catechisms, especially that of Trent, in accordance with each one's ability. To this practice we attach a plenary indulgence each week, provided catechism is studied for one hour and prayers are said for the intentions of the Holy Father.

Receive no cleric, priest or bishop unless they are sent by the Apostolic See and can produce written proof of their Canonical Mission from ourselves. Sadly we report that none of the reverend clergy has seen fit to submit themselves to the Apostolic See and remain under their censures of suspension and excommunication for their various crimes.

Also do not read any book, magazine, paper, etc. that has not received proper ecclesiastical approval, either before the death of our immediate successor, Pius XII or ourselves. We hereby approve the work 'Will the Catholic Church Survive the Twentieth Century?' and encourage study of its contents.

Further we wish to extend Our Apostolic Blessing to all Faithful Catholics scattered throughout the world, especially those, who aided in Our election.

Our Lady of Mount Carmel

We consider the day of Our election very appropriate. The Breviary informs us that Elias founded the community of Mt. Carmel, which "at once embraced the Gospel", and entered the Church on the first Pentecost. We fully expect the two witnesses of the Apocalypse, who are traditionally held to be Enoch and Elias, to begin prophesying soon. With this in mind we wish to encourage all the Faithful to wear the Holy Scapular and observe

the provisions of the Bull of Our Predecessor of happy memory, John XXII:

1. Recitation of the Canonical hours, which for the laity and tertiaries has been commuted to the Little Office of Our Lady and for those who cannot read to observance of the Fast days of the Church.

2. "Moreover, unless through some necessity they be involved in some difficulty, they must abstain from flesh meat on Wednesday and Saturday, except on the Birthday of my Son (Christmas)."

3. Wearing the scapular and enrollment.

To this We add:

1. Those who cannot be enrolled shall receive all the benefits without enrollment, until they can be enrolled. Enrollment received from heretics and apostates shall be considered invalid, even those against whom no sentence has been passed.

2. Those who work may commute the abstinence to partial abstinence and the Office to the recitation of the Rosary. Further commutation may be given by Ourselves in certain cases, and application may be made for this dispensation.
