She is originally from Germany, and a good Catholic, although we do not always agree on everything.

Andre Perlant tells me, that you do not read English, so I hope you can find a translator. Sad to say, the study of languages is neglected in the United States. Through my studies and exposure to various languages, I can understand some Spanish and French, but cannot understand German.

Did Bishop Thuc write a thesis to go with his declaration? If so, I would like a copy in whatever language it exists. The decrees referred to in the Declaration make fruitful reading! Do you have any information on Bishop Thuc's faculty? Did he subdelegate it to other Thuc Bishops? Could they further subdelegate it. (Canon Law forbids this, but the Pope can always grant an exception. An exception should be in writing, so that we can be certain.)

I have in hand the July issue of Einsicht, "Aus den U.S.A. liegen mir Manuskripte von Frau Teresa Benns und David Bawden..." Andre Perlant translates this as, "I have under my elbow some manuscripts from the U.S.A. by Teresa Benns and David Bawden, who are concerned with the building anew of the Hierarchy." We are indeed working toward rebuilding the Hierarchy. We have researched and written for two years on this subject alone, in addition to our years of research, seeking the true situation of the Church before we discovered the Papal Election. Of course, many others have also found the same information, and we wish to work with ANY sincere Catholic, who wants to help rebuild the Church.

The Manuscripts, which you refer to were printed in 'The Francinta Messenger' in this country, as well as distributed by Teresa Benns and myself. We called this, 'Upon This Rock; the Restoration of the Catholic Church.' From the responses, criticisms and questions we are compiling a far longer work, to answer any and all questions and objections to the proposition of a Papal Election. We shall keep you informed of our progress on
