My dear Mr. Eberhard Heller,

I hope that all is going well with you and that you may be enjoying peace and happiness in God our Lord.

I would like to let you know that, together with Father Krier and Mr. Jerrentrup, I have studied and analyzed your Declaration and I also have talked to Mgr. Pivarunas and to Ms. Gloria Riestra about it. We have exchanged opinions and have reached a common opinion regarding the unity of the Church.

Firstly, it must be said that your Declaration is very good, nevertheless it was not satisfactory to Mgr. Pivarunas, myself and Ms. Riestra.

Secondly, the unity of the Church must come from the Hierarchy, in this case, through the Bishops.

I will be attending the Fatima Conference in Spokane, Washington, on this coming month of October (from the 7th through the 13th) and up there I shall have a meeting with Mgr. Pivarunas to discuss the issue. There we shall talk about the unity among the bishops, most specially the Bishops of the Thuc line. Both, Mgr. Pivarunas and I have many similar opinions concerning this subject.

I will inform you of the results achieved in the above mentioned meeting as soon as I return from Spokane top (USA), because I think you should be kept well informed about every aspect concerning the topic, because we all recognize all your great efforts and sacrifices in defense of the Church and I myself will always be very grateful to you for your intercession in favor of the consecration of Mgr. Carmona by Mgr. Thuc.

Regarding our Priestly Fraternity Trento, all its priest have come to the common agreement that the new Bishop should be the Superior, as it is supposed to be.

About the Seminary of Hermosillo, it has always been maintained over the years solely by generosity of the faithful and benefactors through their donations, thanks to Divine Providence of God. When you notified us of the good intentions of the German faithful in help us with donations, it made us all very happy, because that will help the Seminary to grow and through its growth help the work of our good Mgr. Carmona and the Church also.

Mr. Heller, I am sending to you copy of the note I delivered to the Press on the day of my consecration with my theological position. Also, some pictures and a few cards.

I recommend myself to your prayers and impart upon you my Episcopal blessing.
