Dear Dr. Heller:

I sent my last letter to you on May 3, 1982.

Today, I received your letter (card) of May 5, 1982. Thank you for it.
And thank you for giving me your tel.No; what I read this way: 89 (Munche)n811-9568.

Maybe, our letter will cross each other again. But I do not want to wait in answering your letter (5,5,82), because time goes fast, and we need informations from each other rather urgently.

Regarding the consecration^s made by Archbishop Martin Thuc, I have learned that considerable opposition has arisen from the part of Fr. Barbara, and from a group with the name of VEREINIGUNG FUR THE TREUE DER PRIESTER, DER ORDENSLEUTE, UND DER KATOLISCHEN LAIEN.

Against the validity of the consecrations their main argument would be the assertion that ArchB. Thuc is not in possession of a sound mind. Thus, beside Fr. Gerard des Lauriers, and the two Mexicans, he consecrated all sorts of persons, e.g. Jean Laborie, Arbinet, Garcia, Miguet, Schaeffer, etc.

Therefore the following questions must be answered satisfactorily, before we take any further steps.

- 1) Can we have testimony of (medical) experts about the sound mental state of ArchB Thuc; or at least his environment can testify that the ArchB regularly, normally fulfills his daily routine, in saying Mass, preaching sermons, giving lectures, correspondence, - in full possession of mental health. This must be ascertained in the present, that way, that objections, which certainly will come up in the future, too, could be effectively refuted. This is necessary for the defense of the validity of consecrations.
- 2) Is the age of priests, consecrated to bishopric, in harmony with the Canons of Codex Iuris Canonici? (Canon 331, §1, 2° and 3°, etc.)
How old is the youngest of the new bishops, consecrated by ArchB Thuc?
(5:00 P.M. I received your telephone call.)

I was saddened by news of the illness. If it is serious, then, it means a great deal of changes in the plan. Anyway, we will pray for the Archbishop, that he might remain a good tool in the hands of God for the sake of the Church and the souls.

Please, send us some details about his condition, and whereabouts.
