Dear Dr. Heller:

Your last letter to me was dated on May 22, 1982. I answered it on June 1, -82. Since that time I did not receive any communication from you.

On aug 24, 1982, Bishops Carmona, Zamora and Musey came to Buffalo, N.Y., and consecrated to bishopric a Franciscan Father: Louis Vezelis. Fr. Vezelis (now Bishop Vezelis) controls a beautiful large church in Buffalo, N.Y. The ceremonies of the consecration took place in that church. About 150 persons were present beside the clergy. The clergy was represented by 4 old traditionalist priests, and a young one. That is not too many. (The age of Bishop vezelis is over 50 years)

A considerable opposition is attacking the new bishops in this country, among them THE REMNANT with his staff writer, Michael Davies of London, England, and the western part of the Society of St. Pius X.

I am enclosing here a monograph in which I challenged the statements and reasoning of Mr. Walter L. Matt, the editor of THE REMNANT, where he was attacking the new bishops consecrated by Archbishop Martin Thuc.

Also, enclosed is another monograph on the concept of SEDE VACANTE.

Bishop Vezelis, with the help of Bishop Musey, is planning to open a seminary in the old (large) schoolbuilding next door to the churchbuilding in Buffalo, N.Y. The building is empty, and needs a lot of repair-work.

I hope you are all well over there in Europe.

We would like to hear more about Msgr. Martin Thuc.
