This letter confirms my telephone call to Edouard Fosert.

Some time ago, Gloria and I sent you an article in english, defending the consecrations, signed by Rev. James de Kazel. We just learned and confirmed that Rev. de Kazel was ordained priest by an old catholic Bishop Bro. José María, whom has sent you his curriculum vitae.

Please donot publish said article, since we know that left-  
brist circles are aware of the situation of Bro. Jose María and Fr. de  
Kazel, whom by the way, is married. Fr. de Kazel has no theological stu-  
dies.

We have written to Bishop Fusay expl ining him that in our  
opinion any connection with these two persons is detrimental for the cau-  
se, if they repent they should be admitted in the catholic Church as  
laymen.

I hope you are all well. Bishop Vezelis is writing you di-  
rectly about his consecration. He is starting the seminary this septem-  
ber and we plan to send 6 mexican seminarians.

As you know, our government confiscated all banks, and the  
industries on which these banks had stocks. Our government is going toward  
socialism, we have as a nation the highest external debt and cannot pay  
for it. We have total exchange contro, we cannot send dollars out of the  
country. The american bishops will ask for donations to support the me-  
xican seminarians.
