Dear Eberhard:

Enclosed text of the Bishops declaration translated into french. Under separate cover I am mailing you the english translation. The Bishops got together May 24 to 26, and made this declaration. Rather brief. Previously Mgr. Carmona had a meeting with Gloria Niestra, they had drafted a document of 54 pages. He believed that the summary would take 16 pages, it was shorter, translation was cheaper, only 6200 pesos.

Gloria had asked Mgr. Carmona to include in the declaration their proposal to offer their pastoral authority, they did not include it. I sent two men of confidence to organize protection for the Bishops. Both Enrique Salinas and Jose Antonio Garcia Zepeda traveled to Acapulco and stayed there during the meeting, organizing watches, preventing any action of ponceconciliar. Mgr. Thuc came, and Bishop Vezelis also, Bishop Bussey was at Hospital, sick, kindly before publishing the declaration ask him if he agrees to sign it, in order not to omit him. I sent him a copy.

Mgr. Thuc and Bishop Vezelis traveled to Guadalaajara and Colima to meet the families of the mexican seminarians, this was very important. At Guadalaajara they received a donation for their trip..

I only could see Bishop Vezelis and Archbishop Thuc twice at airport. Bishop Vezelis greatest hope is in the seminary. within 2 years he obtains his first priest. These priests will have a solid catholic formation, and will be obedient to the Bishops which is not the case of many priests in USA and Mexico. A priest becomes traditionalist, he does what he pleases, has no authority and he likes it that way.

Letter, Bishop Carmona delivered me an essay on jurisdiction in latin, which I sent to you and Bishop G. des Lauriers. I cannot have this translated locally. No latin translators available. The Bishops are very busy acting as parish priests.

I received the 100 Dlls your kindly sent for expenses, account is as follows:

-Trip and hotel for Salinas and Garcia Zepeda at Acapulco.	5,500 pesos.
Photocopy and mailing the latin essay of jurisdiction to all Bishops, american priests, G. des Lauriers etc.	1,000 pesos.
Translation of declaration into english and spanish.	6,200 pesos.
Photocopy of declaration in english mailing to americana Bishops, etc.	1,000 pesos

Received from you: 1000 Dlls= 14,750 pesos.

After the meeting there was a press conference with local news paper men at Acapulco.

Some local newspapers, published it. The document was given to them. We also photocopied it into Spanish and delivered it to Mexico City newspapers. Two of them published a note on the matter.

I know that Gloria has a Red Bishop Carmona to publish letter the 54 pages document on the Church crisis, it is very well documented, but it is too long. We will see if Bishop Carmona publishes it and is signed by the Bishops.

Regarding Bishop Musey, he will not reordain Bro Jose Maria and James de Kazel. However, James de Kazel became ordained by Bro Jose Maria, and Bishop Musey has him as a priest in Lafayette Louisiana USA. We wrote a letter to the Bishops at Acúlco, but since Bishop Musey was not present, our letter was not read. As you know, de Kazel is a married man, he has a letter from his wife giving him permission to become a priest. I am not a canonist, and all this seems very irregular to me and detrimental for the cause of the Church.


