Received Einsicht december 1982. Very good and oportune answer to Fr. Hector Bolduc.

I find an error in the German edition of Einsicht december 1982. During the end of the Western schism, Gregorius XII and Benedict XIII, both pretending to be Popes at Rome and Avignon (latter at Peñíscola Castle at Spain), were deposed by the Council of Pisa 1409, both as schismatics and heretics, for acting against an article of faith of Bull Una sancta Ecclesia.

The Cardinals of both parties elected Alexander V. In 1410 the Cardinals elected John XXIII, The Council of Constanza was convoked, and during the Council he was deposed by schism, because of simony and scandal. Martin V was elected Pope and the Western schism ended.

I enclose information from a History of the Church printed 1908.

In this same book, it is known that St. Athanasius consecrated Paulinus as Bishop of Antioch. As you know, the Emperor imposed an Antipope Felix at Rome, and banished Pope Liberius, whom under pressure, threat of death and diplomacy signed one of the semiarian formulas of Syrimia, I have not found the text. Under these circumstances St. Athanasius consecrated the Bishop of Antioch, since it is not of apostolic mandate that the Bishops must have letter from the Pope to consecrate Bishop. This is discipline of the Church in normal circumstances.

I hope this information is useful to you.
