I will discuss the following matters in order:

- 1-Regarding rendering to the Bishops Trento , Ariete and Adelante. You wrote about this to Gloria. She thinks that we must be under censorship from them, but they donot have time, since they function as parish priests, to edit the publications.
- 2-We have asked the Bishops whom have a meeting today at Acapulco, to ask Bishop Musey not to beordain Brother José María and James de Kazel. As you can see by the attack published by the lefevbrists in The Roman Catholic, Brother Jose María has been ordained priest and Bishop by Shoismatics, and Boteharh José María ordained the layman James de Kazel. They have defended Bishops Musey and he is grateful for them, but Bishop Zamora has a letter from Brother José María, where he claims to have a message from our Holy Mother that he must become Bishop.
- 3-As you know, JP II was in Central America. Under separatte cover I am sending you an article published from one of our group regarding this visit. The writer, Manuel Magaña is a journalist, has published several books on the Church Crisis, will send you his curriculum vitae.
- 4-I sent you a letter from Carlos Disandro with a suggestion regarding the Conventum or Imperfect Council.
- 5-The liberals here, are organizing a national congress to protest against the economical and political crisis, but praising JP II as an anticomunist hero. We sent you time ago, a publication which we would like to make in the name of Ariete, not Trento, explaining that the crisis is of relisious origin. But we donto have funds to pay for space in the newspapers.

Thank you very much for the record you sent me with Gregorian Chant, it is a Hly Mass I enjoyed it very much. Helps me to rest.

My children will writte to your children and Dr. Hiller children as welll.
