Dear Eberhard:

Your letter October 1st. arrived yesterday.

1) I regret having informed Nicolaas Hettinga about the problem in Rochester. I had no idea that he promoted the consecration of Father Stork and the other priest.

2) Regarding the problem at Rochester, Bishop Carmona knew about it before I did, he informed me by telephone and he decided to go ahead with the consecrations of Father Altenbach and Father Siebert. Regarding the remaining Mexican seminarians they fled out, called asking to get them back.

3) Bishop Musey came to Mexico about 12 days ago. He planned to talk with Bishop Carmona but Bishop Carmona went to Merida Yucatán to obtain a layman as a priest. I do not know the accusations against Father Altenbach. Bishop Musey mentioned that Father Altenbach was under jurisdiction of Bishop Vezelis, and that Bishop Vezelis accepted an old Catholic ordained priest to help old Father Altenbach at Milwaukee chapel. Apparently this priest has not been ordained by old Catholics with apostolic succession.

4) I never dreamed what is happening now. Bishop Gerard des Lauriers is a learned man, great theologian, at his age Konrad Adenauer was Chancellor of Germany. I do not understand how he consecrated Father Stork. Our hope was the Rochester Seminary, hoping to have Catholic young priests loyal to the Bishops. Now, the seminarians are here, Bishop Carmona wants to have Father Ojeda as Rector of the Seminary, young Father Ojeda has not the experience, he just was ordained by Bishop Musey, so the Mexican seminary is a dream.

Bishop Zamora continues in his terrible attitude, I do not refer of his non sense accusations against Bishop Carmona, Gloria and myself. I refer to his public and private heresy: "The Roman Catholic Church fell in heresy after Vatican II". Enclosed letter from September 20th from Bishop Zamora.

Now, to make matters worse, Bishop Carmona ordained a layman with no seminary studies at Merida Yucatán. The name is Francisco Ripoll. The group at Merida is very angry. Gloria, myself asked on knees not to ordain a man without seminary studies. But Bishop Carmona did it. This will bring him founded loss of prestige. Bishop Carmona and Bravo were our last hope in Mexico.

I am without work. Closed my office, I go around looking for work since May. At least you have a Catholic priest. I am glad to know that your daughter Klara received first Communion. We have no mass here at Mexico City. Bishop Bravo came two months ago.

The Lefebvre priests are here in Mexico City.

So many years working to find priests and bishops to preserve the Faith and now this tragedy.
