Dear Eberhard:

I have your letter december 12th., I regret having asked you economical help I did not imagine you are still without work. I received this what I asked you from american friends.

Regarding the UCT Oath. It is true. The rules were made by late Father Juan Correa, Gloria Riestra. Only members of UCT would make Oath against modernism of St. Pius X, and oath to keep secrecy of private matters of UCT.

I must be frank with you, I am disappointed with all what has happened. All small towns are being lost. Father Toledo was expelled by peasants for bad conduct. Father Lavagnini has left since he was not consecrated Bishop. All this is disheartening.

The political and economical situation of Mexico is close to an explosion. 100% inflation. The postconciliar Church using a conservative political party (PAN) to try overthrow our Govt. This would be chaotic, Mexican revolution 1910 to 1929 costed 1 million lives. In this circumstances organized a political group outside UCT, we made a very accurate statement, but unfortunately Bishop Carmona, Gloria are not in agreement with it. We have different viewpoints. There are some of ours whom mistakenly would like to see Govt. go down. Our political group has made no progress because of the opposition I mentioned. But situation in August was very critical the PAN tried to take by force Monterrey city townhall, and they assaulted and burned Agua Prieta townhall. If the postconciliar PAN goes to power they will take everything from us, starting with the two Churches left, Acapulco and Huixtitepec.

I think we need a Bishop like St. Athanasius, we lay people have done our part, but unfortunately we donot have such Bishop. At USA Bishop Altenbach died, Bishop Siebert has an stroke.
