Dear Anacleto,

thank You very much for Your letter which I received this morning. I hope the best for the sickness: all the best and a good health again.

The problem with the bishops looks now for me a little bit different.

1.) Bishop Musey declaired publicly that somebody can be a good catholic and at the same time a good member of the John Birtsh Society.

2.) Fr. Fuhy has been a married man.

3.) The candidats included Fr. McKenna as bishops would do the same as bishop Carmona and Mgr. Bravo: it means as bishops the have done nothing. This Micky-Maus-Declaration which we should support has been a scandal. I have written to Mgr. Musey he should stop directly the stupidity to consecrate candidats they are not worthy. The same I have written to Mgr. Carmona.

I only can ask You on this backround (Mgr. Musey is supported by members of John Birtsh Society) what kind of shism with Mgr. Zamora has happened. Perhaps Mgr. Zamora konws this backround, and he also knows that Mgr. Carmona is too week to refuse Mgr. Musey with his idea to consecrate the american candidates.

We now have here the scandal that Mgr. Guerard des Lauriers has consecrated Fr. Storck, a very intelligent man but totally unworthy as candidate.

When this is going on now in America we make all what we have done totally redicoules and than is finish!

And You can be shure I never will support the stupidities of any one.

God wishes to You and to Your family. We here have a lot of personal problems also. We will pray each one for the other. Please tell Riestra from this letter. She don't take the money for telephoning which we have send to here: it is for here privat life.

And still an other point: Mgr. Carmona should take very, very much care to proof the candidates which he want to ordain or to consecrate. They all shall worke in theological matters. Every where next time ^{are} only bishops and no faithful.

The seminar of Fr. Fuhy - I tell it directly - You can forget soon. (For exemplum: we here in German have had a lot of good politic men. But because they have to do something with the past under Hitler, they never could ~~become~~ get a public office - not to make a scandal.)
