when You have gone with Br. Francis to Paris, next day I have written the enclosed letter to Anacleto Flores in Mexico. This days I have got his answer (also enclosed in copy). It is very painful for me to offer You this letter, but I think the matter of the accusation is to important to be silent. We here would be very glad when You would give out a statement to it.

In an other letter to Mgr. Carmona - whom I also will send a copy of Anacletos letter - I will ask him: What the returned seminarian has told him. Why he had send him to Mgr. Musey's seminar, instead You have refused him as candidate for the priesthood. Why this man has made his great confession to the (from the J.B.S. supported) Bishop Musey.

We will pray, each for the other. Many greetings from my family.
