Thank you very much for your letter from 8th of April.

The questions you give me, we have answered in a public discussion we published in *Einigkeit*,

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when the consecrations were going on ten years ago. There is no force from ^{down} above than all from above.

Mgr. Nj-dunth-Thuc has got a special permission to consecrate bishops by Pope Pius XI. Beside the circumstances are so, that also a consecration is licit and necessary for the survival of the church.

One point here is no solution: because we are living in a time of sede vacancy the bishops has (could) not get a mandatum; there because they have no jurisdiction. When there would be a true Pope they all (the under these circumstances consecrated bishops)

must ask for a mandatum and special jurisdiction.

What's making our resistance ridiculous is the fact that there are consecrated a lot of priests & bishops, they have no idea what's to do and they are personally not able to lead the faithful. They are only interested in personal professions.
