Dear Mister Heller,

Thanks for yours of the 6th inst. I had meant to come and see you one of these days, but it will have to be postponed for one or two weeks. Possibly in the second half of August.

One of these days you will receive some more money, among other things for Holy Masses to be said: this time for:

Mr. and Mrs. A.M.N. Vestering at HAARLEM-Holland. Their daughter/wants me to let you know, that the Masses should not only be said for the souls of her parents, but also for the spiritual benefit of her brothers and sisters, who have completely strayed away from all religion. Mr Vestering, senior, so, her father, died the other day. He has contributed thousands of guilders to "Michaël Legion", the monthly issued by Mr Louis Knuvelde, who died on the 14th of April this year. I will speak to Mrs Vestering, his daughter-in-law, to discuss what should be done with the F.5000,- (Five thousand guilders), that have appeared as a credit-balance-item in "Michaël Legion's" account. Possibly part of it could be used as a contribution to "EINSICHT" and everything it stands for. I'll keep you informed, as soon as I know more.

Please, print the obituary for Mr Knuvelde, that I sent you; it may be a good thing for "EINSICHT" 's readers, that DUTCH is also a spoken language! They will know anyway what is meant by it: For those who know German, (Your French and English readers) it won't be difficult to translate it!

Stuyver, Parish-Priest at Vlassenbroek 50 (9350 BAASRODE); and then there is his brother, Paul Stuyver; Leedse Steenweg 95, (9410 ERPE-MERE); Both have let me know, that they want to RENEW their subscription to EINSICHT for another year: I'll remit their money - together with that for my own subscription - one of these days.

Please, Mr Heller, note, that you need not write to me in English: You may find it easier to write in German. I have NO difficulty reading this.

But I realise that I make too many mistakes when I have to write German. And, again, I know fully well that you have no difficulty reading English. So, if you wish, and if there is something to be written, you write German and I write English: is that OK with you?
