I am sorry for the long delay in thanking you for your letter of the 17th of March, but I have had a long period in bed with chest trouble, mainly due to old age.

I have done a treatise on the Sacrament of Order, which raises many questions regarding the teaching of theologians, not only since Vatican II, but of some of them in the thirties.
