Dear Mr. Bergen:

I owe your address to our correspondence we had some years ago.

I herewith inform you as a member of the community of the Catholic St. Pius V church in Milwaukee, so far ministered by Fr. C.A. Altenbach that Fr. Altenbach, by recently associating himself with "Bishop" Louis Vezelis, normally residing in Rochester, N.Y., as his "Vicar General", can no longer be regarded as a truly Catholic priest dedicated to the pre-Vatican II Catholic Church. For "Bishop" Vezelis belongs to a group of "bishops" whose consecration line was started by "Archbishop" Gdô-dinh-Thuc in 1981, i.e. at a time when Thuc, though obviously validly ordained and consecrated in South Vietnam in the pre-Vatican II era, has lost his power of performing valid ordinations and consecrations by remaining in the Catholic Church organization after its apostasy from the true Catholic faith at Vatican II and its aftermath. He had in the apostate "Catholic" Church organization in the years after 1970 the position of the Titular Archbishop of Bulla Regia and kept this position up to the first months of the present year of 1983, when he was officially excluded from the apostate "Catholic" Church organization by "Pope" John-Paul II.

Gdô-dinh-Thuc was the man who, as a member of the hierarchy of the apostate "Catholic" church organization, performed in Palmar de Troya, Spain, in January 1976 the ordination and consecration of Clemente Dominguez y Gomez, the leader of the Palmar de Troya sect, and of other persons. I enclose a copy of a certificate dated January 12, 1976, and edited by Ngô-dinh-Thuc in Palmar de Troya, in which he identifies himself as the Archbishop of Bulla Regia and, thereby, as a member of the spostate "Catholic" Church organization and, thereby, as an apostate from the true Catholic faith.

The ordinations and consecrations performed by Thuc in Palmar de Troya were, of course not valid, because Thuc had lost his power of validly performing ordinations and consecrations by remaining in the hierarchy of the Catholic Church organization after its apostasy at Vatican II.

I also enclose the text of a declaration made by Thuc in Palmar de Troya, Spain, on January 13, 1976, in which he declared apostate Paul VI as "the true Pope" and, in doing so, confessed himself explicitly as an apostate from the true Catholic faith.

Thuc was officially excluded from the "Catholic" Church organization after his ordinations and consecrations performed in Spain, because he had made them without the permission of the Vatican. But, as a consequence of his efforts, he was soon reinstated as a member of the apostate "Catholic" Church and as the Titular Archbishop of Bulla Regia and kept this position, as the yearly editions of the official papal "Annuario Pontificio" prove, until he was officially excommunicated from the "Catholic" Church organization by "Pope" John-Paul II in the first part of 1983. This excommunication was reported in the news media of the whole world.

With the preceding in mind, there cannot be any doubt that Ngô-dinh-Thuc was an official member of the hierarchy of the apostate "Catholic" Church organization until the spring of 1983. That he kept this position not only formally, but with his own inner consent, is proved by the fact that he called himself "Titular Archbishop of Bulla Regia" even after he had already formed his own church organization by "consecrating" its bishops, as the following Latin text of the title page of the March 1982 issue of the "Einsicht", the official paper of his organization, edited in Munich, West Germany, proves:

The just-mentioned fact proves that Ngô-dinh-Thuc left the apostatic "Catholic" Church organization not before 1983, when he was thrown out of it by force by "Pope" John-Paul II in 1983, i.e. at a time when he had already formed his own church organization and had started it by his "consecration" of the Frenchman P. Gérard des Lauriers on May 7, 1981 and of the priests Moises Carmona and Adolfo Zamora in Toulon, France. These consecrations were invalid since Thuc was, at the time of their performance, a member of the hierarchy of the apostatic "Catholic" Church organization and had, by his own apostasy lost the power of validly performing ordinations and consecrations. He could have regained this power only, if he had, before these consecrations, officially returned to the true Catholic faith by making an official abjuration of his apostasy according to canon 2314 of the Canon Law of 1918. That he did not make such an abjuration, he admitted expressly to me, when I spoke personally with him in the home of Fr. Veselis in Rochester, N.Y., after his Christmas midnight Mass in 1982 in the chapel of Fr. Veselis.

With the preceding in mind, the church organization of Ngô-dinh-Thuc must be regarded as a swindle enterprise promoted by Satan to seduce also the few remaining truly orthodox Catholics.

I ask you, Mr. Bergen, to make this letter known to the true Catholics attending the Masses in the St. Pius V church in Milwaukee and hope that they can find a new, truly orthodox-Catholic pastor for your church, - admittedly a very difficult job in our times.

I shall continue my efforts to find a truly Catholic bishop for the Remnant Catholic Church.
