Your Excellency,

I enclose a copy of my letter addressed to Mr. Thomas Bergen, Milwaukee, which contains my proof that Your Excellency's consecrations of P. Gérard des Lauriers and of the Mexican priests Moises Carmona and Adolfo Zamora in Toulon, France, in 1981 were invalid and that, therefore, the consecrations performed by them, including the consecration of P. Louis Vezelis, are also invalid, because you have lost your power of performing valid consecrations received by your own consecration in the pre-Vatican II era by remaining in episcopal positions in the Catholic Church organization after its apostasy at Vatican II and, thereby, becoming an apostate from the true Catholic faith. You left the apostate church organization, in which you finally had the position of the Titular Archbishop of Bulla Regia, only when you were excluded from it by "Pope" John-Paul II in the spring of our present year of 1983.

Since the invalid consecrations initiated by Your Excellency in obvious unawareness of their invalidity must have terrible spiritual consequences not only for many, many people, but also for Your Excellency, I ask you urgently to inform without any delay the "bishops" of your organization of the invalidity of their consecrations and to stop the activities of your organization immediately. Moreover, I ask Your Excellency in the interest of your own salvation to return to the true Catholic faith by the only way you can legally do it, i.e., by an abjuration of your apostasy from the true Catholic faith and from the true Catholic Church according to canon 2314 of the Canon Law of 1918 the text of which is enclosed in this letter. If You cannot find a Catholic bishop who has not apostatized from the Catholic faith at Vatican II, before whom you can make a valid abjuration, I suggest to you to make a written abjuration and to depose its text somewhere so that it is publicly accessible, e.g. at an attorney's office. After you have made the proposed abjuration and have, thereby, returned officially to the Catholic faith, you can again legally exercise your priestly and episcopal powers and can again offer valid Tridentine Masses.

As long as you do not have made the proposed formal abjuration of your apostasy from the true Catholic faith and, thereby, have formally returned to the true Catholic faith, your Latin Tridentine Masses which you presently celebrate in the chapel of P. Vezelis in Rochester, N.Y., are invalid and, therefore, a deception of the people who attend them, with terrible consequences regarding your own salvation.

Such terrible consequences have also to be expected by your Excellency, if you do not inform the people who attend the religious functions of the "bishops" and "priests" of your organization of the invalidity of these functions.

If Your Excellency regard a further discussion of the above-treated matters as useful I invite you to a visit in my home in Caledonia, N.Y. which is located about 20 miles south of Rochester, N.Y.. If you intend to follow up my invitation, I shall pick you up with my car at the home of P. Vezelis in Rochester. Your visit in my home would also give me an opportunity of showing you my beautiful chapel accomodating in its pews about seventy people. Now, with all good wishes to Your Excellency, I am
