Dear Dr. Heller,

Laudetur Jesus Christus!

Many thanks for the December Special Number of Einsicht which arrived yesterday. I also thank you for your recent letter, where you supplied the addresses of some of the Bishops. Einsicht is an excellent, scholarly, Catholic publication; it's the best I've seen. I haven't found such a good periodical in the English-speaking world.

Although you don't list John XXIII as a heretic, I think he was one. It's my opinion Roncalli was not a pope, and that in fact, Pius XII was the last Vicar of Christ. More research needs to be done into the life and work of Roncalli. The little evidence so far uncovered about him shows he was an enemy of the Church. St. Pius X was the last truly great Pope we have had. Unfortunately, all his successors to some degree did questionable things. This is documented in the (Lefebvriest!) publication from New York called The Roman Catholic. In a series of articles authored by Mary Martinez, it is shown how Popes Benedict XV, Pius XI and Pius XII wittingly, or unwittingly, laid the groundwork for Vatican 2.
