Sehr verehrter Herr Dr. Heller,

Man könnte (nur einen Vorschlag) vor den Artikel schreiben: "The new Pope makes pilgrimages to Loreto, to Knock, etc., as if he were a lover of Tradition, but that ~~this~~ these pious actions are part of a double-play on his part is evident from the following article from a recent issue of the Texas monthly The Angelus written by the American traditionalist journalist and lecturer, Mary Martinez."

No one has greater distrust of Wojtyla than I do, not even you, believe me. I spent one and a half hours with Msgr. Lefebvre at Econe speaking privately to him about the new Pope, showing him how I learned from the Figaro correspondent that Bishop Wojtyla is the protegé of Lefebvre's arch-enemy, Cardinal Garonne, etc. But even in Kansas, at St. Mary's, the huge new Pius X center, he went on about the Holy Father receiving him, etc. etc. and (according to the news agencies) said the Pope had not condemned the ordinations of June 29. No, but he was told clearly through the Nuncio in Bern that the ordinations must not take place and that the Archbishop must instead come again to Rome for consultations with Card. Seper. He refused both requests and went ahead. He said to me, "what do they want to talk about? They know all about me. I'm just a Roman Catholic, that's all and they ought to know what that is without more discussions." Anyway, several days ago ~~Vatican Radio~~ the Vatican Press Officer told us that nothing has changed in the Lefebvre case that all rumors of a reconciliation with the disobedient bishop are groundless.

Please forgive my German. Please do not fail to write to me after you have read the book.
