Dear Dr. Heller:

Today I received your letter with the request for my CURRICULUM VITAE. You will find it enclosed in this letter. I suppose, that in case of publication, the references to third parties (names and addresses) will not be printed.

I sent the same CURRICULUM VITAE to the address of Archbishop Martin Thuc, - and to Mr. Gonzales Flores in Mexico, according to his request.

Regarding the possible future consecrations, I sent a few words of caution to Mr. Flores. (A photocopy of it is also enclosed in this letter.)

Notes of explanation: ORCM = ORTHODOX ROMAN CATHOLIC MOVEMENT, was established in the USA by Father Francis Fenton in 1973, for preservation of the Catholic Faith and True Sacrifice of the Mass. However, in 1979 Fr. Fenton left the ORCM and set up his own organization. At the present time, Father Robert McKenna, O.P. is the executive Secretary of the ORCM, and whenever it is possible, he prefers to use the name "CATHOLICS FOREVER", in order to avoid the misconceptions connected with the word ORTHODOX.

We would like to hear more about the Seminary that Archbishop Martin Thuc is going to start in MÜNCHEN. Is it started already? How many Professors does it have? And who are they? How many Seminarians are there? What is the language of teaching? - At our latest convention with the ORCM (April 13-14), we also discussed the necessity of setting up a Seminary here in the United States. But - so far, - this is just an idea, nothing else.

In my letter of April 16, 1982, I mentioned that the two Mexican bishops will come to Dallas, Texas, for a meeting and celebration. Well, the meeting had to be postponed, because the bishops did not get the necessary visa.

In the same letter I asked you to give me your telephone-number, if in any urgent case there will be a need to contact you. But if you have your personal reasons not to give it away, I do not insist of receiving it. (It is to be understood, however, that my knowledge in German is not enough to speak fluently through the phone. I speak English and Hungarian.)

In any case, I would like to visit the new Seminary in MÜNCHEN before the winter. It was six years ago when I spent two days in MÜNCHEN.

Thank you again, Dr. Heller, for your letter and time.
