Thank,you very much for your nice calender from München,but first of all I am very grateful for those two " DIRECTORIUM" which are very practical. I really appreciate it .

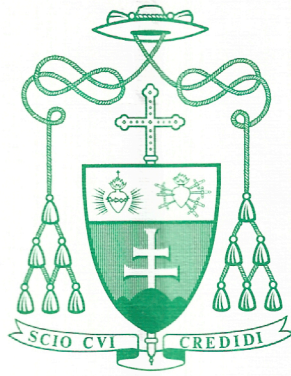

In Prešov April 16, 1991.
