Very esteemed Mr. Heller:

Thank you for your letter of December the fifth. I am very glad to have news from you, because we know about the great friendship that you maintained with Mons. Carmona.

We recognize the trascendental job of the group of "Una Voce" and the work of Miss Gloria Riestra by having promoted the consagracion of Mons. Carmona. We really are very grateful with you, because without the fact of the consagracion, the creation of our seminary and all we have done it wouldn't be possible.

Following, I will give you the information you request about our work in México.

Since the sad tragedy of Mons. Carmona, we have made an effort to maintain and increase his work. He did not leave a sucesor here in México. We were left without bishop. Many people thought that everything would collapse, but thank God tha opposite happened, all the sacrifices that Mons. Carmona did, were not in vain and now they continue giving fruit.

Nowadays, we assist ten parishes in: Acapulco, Dos Caminos, Huitziltepec, Guadalajara, Hermosillo, Ciudad Juárez, Torreón, Oaxaca and Veracruz. We also assist almost thirty missions in almost all the country. We are thirteen priest in total, nine of us came out from Mons. Carmona's Seminar.

We have seventeen students in the Seminaries, ten in the mayor seminary on Hermosillo and seven in the minor seminary of Ciudad Juárez. We have found a convent of nuns here in Hermosillo, two churches have been built, the first stage of the seminary was also built but the space there is really not enough for the seminarians and we need to enlarge it because they no longer fit more.

Beside all this, another two churches are being built, and we should already begin the construction of the convent for the sisters.

As for the way we have been organized after the death of Mons. Carmona, we decided to establish a sacerdotal society in order to preserve the joint between us; that's why Trento Sacerdotal Society was created named whose first superior was your servant Father Daniel Pérez for three years. Father Dvid Contreras was named for the next period. Now, I'm in charge of the direction of the Trento Magazine and I also assist the parish of Hermosillo and for cities on the North of México and the spiritual direction of the convent and I teach lessons in the seminar. As you can see we all really have a lot of work.

Thank God we have not been abandoned at all, Mons. Carmona was certain in consecrating Mons. Mark Pivarunas from U.S.A. before he died. Mons. Pivarunas shows to us with much carity and he always has assisted us with sacraments, visiting us three or four times a year, he feels a commitment toward us as an inheritance on Mons. Carmona.

I am sending you some pictures and some Trento magazines so you can have more information about us.

Please send me the address of Father Krier, I assist the border with California, U.S.A. and I may be in poossibility to visit him.

About Mons. Dolan, we do not wish to maintain any relationship with him or any other person who does not have a right intention.

On the other hand, I am compiling biographical data of Mons. Carmona with the intention of writing a book about his life and works later. Do you have any material that could serve us ? If you do, would you mind sending us copies?

We hope to continue having good relationship with you. If you are interested in publishing any of our articles in your "EINSICHT" magazine please feel free to do it.
