Dear Dr. Heller -

Many thanks for kindly sending me the March issue of the "Einsicht" which gave me an opportunity to know what goes on in the Catholic world. My candid opinion is that the candle-stone consecrations will not be favourably received by most conservative Catholics. Palmer should have been a lesson, however well-meaning it may be to continue the priesthood. It will not restore the Church.

I really do not agree to calling the blasphemy of the Novus Ordo a "Mass" which is the same for Catholics and Protestant. In fact the Protestants don't want it — and as for Catholics, they have been robbed of their birth-right which God gave to them on their baptism: — The immutable Catholic Latin Mass. Catholics have obedience to papacy engraved on their conscience, whilst the disobedience of original sin runs in their veins. So it comes that the image of worship the perfidious Montini forced on the faithful became unacceptable to them. It is not a case which kind of mass "pleases the Lord". There is only one mass.
