1.- Theologically there is not any mistake about dogmas. All the work consists in a personal apretiation of the problems of the Sede Vacante.

2.- He insists in the urgence of have a catholic Pope. The necessity of the election of one by the sedevacantists.

3.- He remember the case of the occidental chisma, and the doctrine of León XIII about the Church in problems for election of popes in the case of dificulties.

4.- He seas the necessity of the union of all "sedevacantists", of all those taht in the world are affirming that the Saint Chair is empty.

5.- He says he is working for this union, but he don't says if he is doing this alone or with a group.

6.- He mentions you as the pioner in the study of the problem of the jerarquy restablation in present circunstances.

7.- He mention the mistakes of Mgr. Guérard de Lauriers and those that are with him, in his doctrine you know about the pope at present.

8.- He comments about the other groups he knows that don't recognize that the Saint Chair is empty, as the "guerardians, lefebrists, de Nantists, Barbarians", but he don't says haw to convince them.

9.- He don't mention exactly which are all the groups that in the world affirm that the Chair is empty. He mentions you and Einsicht, and the

10.- He doesn't mention Mgr. Thuc and his bishops.

11.- He mentions you several times, as you can see in the articles.

Now, my personal opinion, as always wishing hear yours. It is only an opinion.

1.- I am also sure as Mr. Tello that the final solution of the present problem is in the catholic Pope's election. But,

2.- I don't think it can be immediately as Mr. Tello purposes. It is good to look for the union, but who is going to be the "connection" soon?.. Precipitation can not be good. There is a great confusion in the traditionalists world. I think it is necessary a work with those -that are the majority- that are in the middle of the way; I don't think all them are stop for a bad intention. If we now, soon, elect a Pope, without having do a work for approximate the others, may be this would not give the necessary fruits. I think to have a Pope is necessary, but not so urgently looking at all the circumstances.

The bishops that are of the succession of Mgr. Thuc are several, and we have not union in them!...

Well, I think that we must know exactly who is Mr. Tello, if he is alone or with a group, and which are his plans exactly, principally when he is mentioning you so frequently. His intention can be very good, but we have to know his methods, and intentions before seconding his ideas that are very good, but of great consequences. We can imagine if someones in a precipitation act elect a Pope, that don't likes to us other, and so, and so, with the argument that it is urgently to have a Pope. Who shall decide if that Pope is legitime or not?

I think the next step is to study what shall be the rules for a legal election in the actual conditions. If we have conclusions about this, then we would be able to go on at first in the work to know all about all the traditionalist groups in the world.

This last I say I think is the most important now. Rules for a legitime election. Pope's election.

It is not enough to think: we are in the "Vacantis Sedis" position, so we can elect a Pope. As you know, we are in the most difficult crisis in all the Story. I don't know if I am prudently more of the convenient, but I see a danger in precipitation.

Carmona is coming next 15 of april, and I will ask him to take with him t. ~~information~~, Mr. Tello's ~~information~~, or adress, and I think to write him not in the name of Mgr., Carmona or the Union, but personally, to know more about him, and I will tell you about when I have news. I am not going to say Mr. Tello nothing of my thoughts. Only that I wish to know more about him.

And with other news, Mgr. Carmona has been seek; we think it is a cause of his age; he is 79 old. He has a great preoccupation to have a sucesor, but his priest are very young; we will talk about this when Mgr. comes.

This is what I think about Mr. Tomas Tello. I repit the articles have not mistakes in dogmatic questions. It is only that it seems to me that a Pope's election at present requires a **great** prudence, studies, and to leave clear many questions before to work in the union of the catholics. It is necessary to take not only the decision, but to have solutions to the problems that are great, and work after this with a Plain of action.
