+ Dear Doctor Heller,

I had a chance to read one of your latest "Einsicht" and found it very interesting, and also mostly in agreement with our own opinions about the present crisis in the Church and how to heal it, and restore the Church to her former glory.

This task is certainly not easy since there are so many divergent and, unfortunately, often opposing views on almost all matters, especially the Papacy and the Liturgy. Our position is, return to the Liturgy of St Pius V (Tridentine) with certain exceptions of which we write in the present issue of the *Regnum Dei*, because that's the only remaining plank of salvation, by clinging to which we may be certain to be rescued sooner or later.

The most urgent task is, of course, to provide for a new Pope. This must be done by us, the people and clergy, since the official hierarchy has all but apostasied from the Faith and from the Tradition. In this vein, and in this hope, I am writing to you: that, namely, you may prove a valiantfighter for this cause and together we might bring about, if we succeed in recruiting others, the election of a new Pope and the lawful restoration of Catholic hierarchy. For only a Pope can appoint bishops and consecrate them or, at least, delegate this power to three other bishops.

Please also send me your catalogue of traditional books. I am special interested in Breviaries (printed before 1912), in Missals dating back hundred or more years, in *Rituale Romanum* (also dated before 1912), in *Graduale*, *Vesperale* and *Antiphonale Romanum* (the older the better), and other similar books. Please let me know if you have any of the above.
