Dear Dr.Heller:

Thank you for your greetings for this Easter. Although this letter will not reach you before Easter, I wish to extend my sincere greetings to you and your family for a blessed Easter season.

I have not had the time to write to you because of many things. Your article in the Einsicht regarding what I had written about bishops does not please me because it fails to take into consideration the very essence of the Church - that it is the Mystical Body of Jesus Christ.

I am sorry to say that your conclusions result in the same kind of dilemma as that of Msr.des Lauriers, etc. The only alternative that is consistent with reality is to conclude that the Catholic Church no longer exists. But, that is impossible. The Church will exist until the end of time. And, as far as I can determine, time has not ended yet.

I do not wish to enter into a discussion here. But I would like to give you a series of tapes concerning Msgr.Musey's attempted "take-over" of the Schuckardt Sect in Spokane, Washington. There are two parts: the first part which I call "THE COURTSHIP" and the second part which I call "THE DIVORCE". It becomes clear from the conversation that Msgr.M is a charlatan. Unfortunately, he is an episcopal charlatan.

The document which you sent me cannot be accepted as PRIMA FACIE evidence because it must first be clearly established that it is not a forgery. I have reason to believe that those who are using M.Laurent as a "Secretary of State" and his pagan wife for a "Holy Office" have great ambitions that make everyone look ridiculous.

Msgr.Ngo was not very prudent. I think it is most ridiculous to be promoting him as a "servant of God" - the first step towards his canonization! This is being done by the crazy Frenchmen.

I am very fortunate that in my spiritual formation that I was trained by German Franciscans: they were very strict - but not crazy. They came from Germany during Bismark's kulturkampf. In the United States, they had the reputation of being the strictest observance.

We will have another priest on June 13, 1987. He will be ordained in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. We have two seminarians presently in first year of theology. We expect a young man to enter in May to study for the priesthood. Another man is coming to become a Brother. Fr.Francis is in charge of our little school in Rochester.

Mr. Francis had another daughter. He also had an operation for open heart and is doing very well. Just now his little daughter of three years old came in to say 'hello'. Mr. No is printing in the basement and his daughter is playing outside with her little cousins.
